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Dear all,

I am writing this email to inform you that **this will be my last and final email to most of you**. You can read about my post on sex and sin when it comes out on my site, and I'm sure you are more than capable of finding the link to my site should you wish to do so.

I will start the work on gathering the 144,000 and would be unlikely to require your assistance anymore. I am grateful for the assistance and help you have provided so far up to this point, and I apologise for any trespass throughout this journey.

Dear all,

Hopefully this email will be the last from me and apologies again for the recent email bombardment. I will give up trying to convince anyone for the foreseeable future until the time comes and he tells me to. I have tried and I genuinely do not care if anyone believes me anymore. I'm just a messenger and it's the Lord who does the persuasion and not me.

If possible, I would like some advice regarding the guidance of the Holy Spirit vs scripture. In the early days when I was exploring my faith, I was repeatedly reminded that there are multiple versions of the bible even in English alone, and unless I learn Hebrew I won't be able to read the original texts. There are enough attempts in history to use God's word as a tool of control and manipulation. I know China is trying to reinterpret scripture if not outright rewrite it. As a bilingual speaker, I also know lost in translation is a real thing. Although the weird thing is, I don't even need to read scripture proactively, most of the time I was led to scripture one way or another and the content would justify the action that I was going to take or planning to take. They also give me courage and strengthen my faith in him. It's almost like he just clears the path for me to walk. The only thing I need to do is to have faith in him and he just provides. This is how I ended up walking into the Vatican city with two lighters in my pocket, but I have quit smoking now in case next time I get tempted by some gasoline prepared by the devil. I have also prayed for him to take my wrath away. The wrath belongs to him and him alone. In case you are wondering, I realised what my insane tour around the globe was on the last day. I sent [this](#) to a couple of friends to reassure them that I have faith in God's righteousness before I flew to Rome. I realised the global tour was my oath of allegiance to him.

When he came to me in those three days back in August, he promised me three things and the first two are show me what I want to see and take me where I want to go. I was totally uninterested in the last thing he offered me and I realised now that it's good that I didn't want it, otherwise he probably would've sent me to hell straight away. Lastly, I have a suspicion that the mark of the beast 666 is not an actual mark in the physical world, but a mark in the spiritual world. In the book of revelation, it says the mark will be on people's foreheads and right hands. The idea of having 666 on people's foreheads nowadays in the physical world seem rather insane even for someone as far gone as me, and I don't see how it could actually happen given we also have the warning in scripture. I believe right hand symbolises righteousness according to scripture. How many people in this world still consider God to be righteous rather than consider money to be righteous, and have God in their mind rather than money? It says people cannot buy or sell without it, it's been the case since we had money. So I think 666 is a spiritual mark and it represents money or the love of it in the real world. I would appreciate any thoughts and inputs regarding this theory.

I'm also not so sure about my own salvation anymore. I believe instead I will be judged on the day, the same as everyone else. And the last question I would like to leave with everyone is, do you have faith in God above? I do.

Just want to provide a quick update in case anyone is concerned over my well-being. In my typical fashion, I changed my mind again shortly after writing my previous email and jumped on a flight back to Hong Kong on 3rd Oct with three bibles in my bag and no change of underwear. I met with Pastor Xander at Hong Kong Baptist Church before travelling into mainland China for a three day trip Jonah style. Surprisingly I managed to get back to Hong Kong unscathed and attended three church services this past weekend. Whilst waiting for the Sunday evening service at the China Congregational Church, Hong Kong, I realised I need to give the pastor the following message - he's coming home.

I arrived at San Francisco last night and thought I was here to spread the gospel to my Chinese high school friends. A lot of them are currently working/studying in the US and we all went to Sun Yat-Sen Memorial Secondary School, a school that was set up in memory of the founding father of Republic of China, whom I found out to be a Congregational Christian when visiting Pastor Xander for the second time after my trip to mainland. Earlier this morning I realised my mission in the US is indeed to spread the gospel, but to believers rather than non-believers.

Feel free to interpret this email however you wish. I decided not to proceed with the psychological assessment recommended by Pastor Duncan, although I remain grateful for his good will. I believe without a doubt that I have gone absolutely bat shit crazy. I realised on the day I first met Pastor Xander that taking the leap of faith is the same as going insane, because you believe he will catch you rather than letting you smash into the ground by faith alone rather than reason. Regrettably I have to inform you that I have gone way beyond insanity at this point, because I will take the leap of faith for any non-zero probability that all the suffering in this world will have meaning, regardless of whether he will catch me. Before you get overly concerned, I don't think I will be jumping off any cliff any time soon, and I will only take that leap after carefully reasoning the trade-offs. I have also cc'd my therapist Fraser in this email and I have faith in him to continually safeguard my mental well-being.

Btw, I believe I have found my calling as well. It's arguably the same thing every Christian tries to do on a daily basis - I'm going to bring him home. Hope to see you all again when I'm in England and please take care before then.

I do have one further hypothetical thought experiment/question that I would like to ask and cc'd Rev. Keyworth and Pastor Duncan. Feel free to ignore as well since I have been bothering everyone quite a lot lately.

I had a brief discussion with Rev. Keyworth last week regarding the book of revelation and would like to set out the thought experiment below.

Presume the existence of the Holy Spirit and the beginning of the end are both a posteriori knowledge. We can have three possible futures as listed below.

2. Book of Revelation is merely a rhyme in history - events are going to unfold metaphorically and time goes on as usual.
3. Book of Revelation is just a made up story in the bible - time goes on as usual.
